These are intended to be "short answer" (key phrases or one sentence) questions! Use a separate sheet of paper for your answers. The questions are generally in the same order as the material in your text book. *Note that question #1 counts 24% of this quiz grade.*

1. Have you read all of the required material in the textbook (pages 361 - 393)?
2. From where does Peter's 1<sup>st</sup> epistle *claim* to be written from? Why do we think this is a "code" to mean somewhere else? From where was 1 Peter *really* written?
3. Name the 4 major divisions of Peter's 1<sup>st</sup> epistle.
4. Name the 6 major divisions of Peter's 2<sup>nd</sup> epistle.
5. Where did John minister after the fall of Jerusalem in 70 AD? Approximately when did he die?
6. John mentions his reasons for writing 13 times within his 1<sup>st</sup> epistle. Give 2 of those reasons.
7. What was Jude's relationship to Jesus?
8. What was Jude's purpose in writing his epistle?
9. Approximately how many visions are contained in the book of Revelation?
10. Who wrote the book of Revelation? What was the author's relationship to Jesus?
11. Where was the book of Revelation written? Why was the author there?
12. When was the book of Revelation most likely written? Who was the Roman Emperor at the time?
13. List the chain of events that occur according to the *historic premillennial* view of Revelation. (Hint: If you have trouble understanding the textbook for these next 4 questions, check out [http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Christian\\_eschatological\\_differences](http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Christian_eschatological_differences) on the web.)
14. List the chain of events that occur according to the *dispensational premillennial* view of Revelation.
15. List the chain of events that occur according to the *amillennial* view of Revelation.
16. List the chain of events that occur according to the *postmillennial* view of Revelation.
17. What is *universalism*? Why is it wrong? (Hint: see the yellow box on page 382.)
18. List 3 ways in which the NT reflects continuity with the OT.
19. List 5 areas that the textbook classifies as "unfinished business" for the modern church.
20. What does "contextualization" mean, in the context of Biblical studies?
